

Field Service Systems Technician

Typical brands to service and install would be Dometic, Sea Recovery, Headhunter, Vacuflush, Marquipt, and Seakeeper, etc. Candidates must own their own hand tools, along with a good multimeter. Tool refinancing program is available to build your own tool inventory. Field service technicians typically work onsite, and across the Gulf Coast.

Qualifications:

- Experience with HVAC, refrigeration, electrical and hydraulic systems, and be mechanically inclined.
- Current HVAC certifications are a plus!
- You must be able to represent our company in the field with minimal supervision.
